### What is Elks Camp Barrett?

Elks Camp Barrett is an American Camping Association accredited camp, designed to help young people from all backgrounds develop and grow by affording the opportunity of getting outdoors for adventure and fun. It is operated by the Elks Association of Maryland, Delaware and the District of Columbia. Campers are sponsored by local Elks Lodges and all or a portion of the cost of camp is covered by that sponsorship.

### Who can go to Camp?

Any youth between the ages of 9 and 13 (or completed 3rd grade) from the Maryland, Delaware or the Washington, D.C. area is eligible. They do not have to be needy but should be worthy and deserving or one who would not otherwise have such an opportunity for a camping experience.

### How do you apply for Camp Barrett?

Families who are interested in sending their child to Elks Camp Barrett should contact an Elks Lodge in their area. A Camp Barrett Representative from that Lodge will provide a pre-registration packet and can answer any questions you may have about the camp and the registration process. Camp weeks fill quickly. Spaces are not guaranteed and fill on a first come first served basis.
